JM opened meeting at 8:35 PM. - Minutes from prior month reviewed and approved.

MONTHLY UPDATE – Jamie McSwaney (JM) JM Reported:

- See attached Notice of Action re: Farm League Incident. Farm League Coaches Vresko and Schnepp attended meeting and statements are below:
 - o Larry Schnepp
 - Read a written statement.
 - Offended by perception that parent testimony and video were considered by the board without context. Felt that we should have a sit-down discussion with coaches and assistants.
 - Believes the root issue is lack of independent ump at games. Believes it forces him to be 'harder' on his own team on balls & strikes.
 - Didn't feel that it was expressed to him that it is a development focused league. Thought Tball was for development and that the kids benefit from competition.
 - Believes his coaching philosophy is goal-oriented, tries to motivate players. Discussion of maximum effort mentality.
 - Felt they were being cheated in the game. Didn't feel he handled the situation correctly, but thought he was standing up for what was right.
 - SABA President Response:
 - Of course it is important to win, but focus is on development. No place for cheating but need to be aware of the age and talent of the children.
 - When we have 14 parents reach out, league is given no choice but to act swiftly
 - Discussion will still happen with coaches and commissioner re: rules and what may/may not be working
 - Pointed out that there is the first time in President's 5 years in farm league that this has been an issue. Unacceptable.
 - SABA VP Response:
 - Appreciates accountability taken.
 - Root issue may well be the rules and interpretation of the rules.
 - O Does not believe umps are necessary at this age.
 - SABA Treasurer Response:
 - Given the age, the focus 100% needs to be on development. This is what allows for continuity of the league. Cannot allow competition to weed out kids in the community because they don't have talent at this age.
 - Discussion of the winning/losing being an aspect of the game but absolutely not the point.

- SABA Tball Commissioner
 - Praise for both coaches, assets as volunteers
- SABA Minor Commissioner
 - Works with leagues above and below that level to bridge and continue development
- SABA Secretary:
 - Ask that if anything ever rises to the level where it's about to explode, please address before it gets to that point
- Rob Vresko
 - Discussion of scenarios that lead to the incident
 - Believes that board members that have personal ties to the Angels team cannot be partial
 - Details of incidents laid out in parent testimonies. Any additional details below:
 - Mention of child with behavioral issues that requires extra atio during games
 - During points of contention throughout the game, felt that Pirates coaches were outwardly aggressive
 - Felt he couldn't constructively help players on the other team with the baseline issue without animosity from Pirates coach
 - Examples of times Pirates coach pushed limits various instances
 - Felt attacked and "backed into a corner" in the situation at hand
 - Suggestions for board actions in situations like this moving forward
 - SABA President Response
 - Ultimately, we have responsibility for safety of players, coaches, parents.
 There has to be accountability for losing tempers at any time.
 - SABA VP Response
 - Discussion about what could be handled differently
